

# Conditions of Borrowing DXL651



1. DXL651 is owned by The Morgan Three Wheeler Club. This means that it is jointly, and equally, owned by every club member. Therefore every club member has an equal right to apply to borrow the car. However, it is also borrowed with the permission of other club members. The Club Chairman or Club Secretary will have the right to refuse any application, at their discretion, on behalf of the membership.
2. This scheme is managed by Ross Herbert, who maintains the car.
3. Any club member who borrows the car must be over 25yrs of age and have held a full driving license for at least 12 months. You can borrow the car even if you have penalty points on your license but these must be for speeding only. No Dangerous Driving or Alcohol convictions. Proof of this will be required upon collection.
4. An insurance scheme is in operation. This insurance scheme must be used even if you have insurance of your own.
5. No club member can book the car more than 6 months in advance. Ross Herbert will co-ordinate all bookings and can be contacted on 01886 884362 or at [ross@hareleyfarm.co.uk](mailto:ross@hareleyfarm.co.uk)
6. No club member can make more than one booking at a time. That is, when you have booked the car for a specific date you cannot make a further booking until your first booking has passed.
7. When the car is booked for a specific date a 2nd and 3rd name will be taken for those dates. In the event of a club member having to withdraw then the 2nd is given the option of taking up the booking. Likewise the 3rd if required. Notice of cancellation may incur a financial penalty.
8. Bookings will normally be for a weekend Saturday and Sunday. Mid-week days may also be considered. Longer bookings may be considered - for example it would be acceptable to borrow the car for a "long weekend", for the AGM or other "special events. Telephone Ross to discuss your requirements.
9. In all circumstances the car is to be collected and returned to the workshop, that is, Hareley Farm, Linley green Road, Whitbourne, Worcestershire WR6 5RF. This includes in the event of breakdown. If the club member cannot facilitate this then breakdown/rescue cover is recommended. It will always be the club members' responsibility to ensure the car is returned.
10. In the event of breakdown or damage which Ross Herbert judges to be the fault of or negligence of the club member who borrows the car then the club member agrees to contribute towards cost of parts to repair the car. This will be arbitrated by the Club Chairman, Ross Herbert or another authorized club member who will carry out the repair.
11. The car is a 1930s Morgan cycle car in standard condition. It is *not suitable for races, rallies, sprints or trials*. We ask you *not to use it on motorways or dual carriageways* which are too fast for the car and will cause damage.

(This may seem harsh. However; I have owned Morgan 3 Wheelers in the past, so I am aware that they can sometimes break without warning, and without the fault of the driver. We will always try to come to an amiable agreement with the driver in these circumstances. In the same way, we hope that borrowers will understand that they are borrowing a car that is 70yrs old. Reliability cannot be guaranteed like a modern car. Please remember, the car is owned by all MTWC club members, including the borrowers, who are responsible for their own safety when using the car. Please drive it with due care. To assist in this borrowers are asked to allow time to collect the car. They will be asked to assist while the car is checked over (oil, water, tyres, etc) to familiarize themselves with the car and to reassure themselves that the car is ready for use. This is only what any normal MTWC member does with their own car

before a run. Ross will then take you on a short run to ensure you are happy with the car. All of this will hopefully ensure you enjoy your time with the car to the full. Please note that the car is borrowed entirely at the member's risk.) **Please note also no Motorway Driving is allowed in the F4.**

12. COSTS: You are not hiring the car. Club members are borrowing their car from the custodian. However, donations towards its upkeep are accepted from borrowers.

Suggested donation to borrow the car for a weekend (with insurance): £45.00

Trailer hire is available: 1st day £35, each additional day £20 or £70 per week. Please indicate if this is required when booking.

Donations and trailer hire charge are due upon collection. If you feel you cannot meet the above requirements then please do not apply

Please note: the car is collected with a full tank. Please ensure you return it the same way.
